Who:

The Commission is made up of nine (9) regular members and two (2) alternates. When a regular member is absent an alternate will sit in at the meeting as a voting member. Terms are for two (2) years at which time commissioners may apply for a vacant position. All volunteers must be a residents or employees of the City of Schertz.

What:

The purpose of the Schertz Transportation Safety Advisory Commission is to investigate safety issues and make recommendations with respect to our city's roadways. Improve our city's quality of life through a citizen-government partnership. Promote safe and secure roads which provide convenience, recreational and leisure activities and continued beautification of the City of Schertz.
