**Initial certification students must attend all scheduled classes. Students in the Remedial (24 hours) and Re-certification (48 hours) courses must attend the classes indicated.**

**Clinical Rotations begin on February 2nd and must be completed by the end of the course. All clinical paperwork is due on April 14th. You will be required to complete 24 hours of hospital ED rotations (with a minimum of five (5) written Patient Contact Reports); and 40 hours of ambulance rotations (with a minimum of five (5) documented patient transports) at the approved clinical and field internship sites as outlined in the Student Policy Manual.**
